As you have rightly requested public input concerning the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) controversial high production volume (HPV) chemical-testing program, please consider the following:

*It is my contention that NIEHS should immediately put into use the new non-animal test methods. Research accepted by the scientific community proves conclusively that animals need not continue to suffer and die as a result of bureaucratic inertia.

*Government agencies should use in vitro cell culture tests to COMPLETELY REPLACE the use of animals in lethal dose tests.

*The tenets set forth in your October 1999 agreement with the animal protection community must be adhered to.
